





SYG 2016 - 20th Anniversary

It can be really tough to get church youth and young adults together in the one place, and even harder – sometimes it feels impossible! – to introduce non-Christian young people to Christian life and to Jesus.

To help churches with both of these aims, for the last nineteen years, Churches of Christ in SA has been running State Youth Games. SYG is a four-day, sports based camp for youth and young adults (ages 15 and up). Church groups enter a 'team' for the weekend (think of it like a 'nation' in the Olympics), and team members then participate in different sports of their choosing.

A day at SYG includes an early morning devotion, several hours of sport, meals, a

night worship service and free 'community time.'

It's lots of fun and a casual, non-threatening environment for non-Church youth and young adults to encounter a Christ-like community and hear about Him. We've had many participants in the past blown away by how kind and welcoming everyone is.

In 2016, the 20th anniversary SYG will be held **at Unity College**, **Murray Bridge from the 10th - 13th of June**. If you have any youth or young adults who might possibly be interested, we invite you to put the dates in your diary and get in touch.
